- The first Rogate School was founded by Colonel Charles Wyndham in 1841, and the original building still stands in Sandy Lane
- In 1867, a "National School" was built on the present site, and on the 23rd April 1948, Rogate School became a "Controlled" School
- In 1962, the school was re-modelled and enlarged, although most of the original building was retained, forming the present school hall, office and staffroom
- Outside there is a learner swimming pool and extensive playing fields, with an environmental study area

- Rogate School is a Church of England (Controlled) School.
- The postal address is Hampshire and the school is only 3 miles from Petersfield, but Rogate is located in West Sussex
- We currently accommodate children in three classes from Reception Year (age 4) to Year 5 (age 10), but from Sept 2009 we will include Year 6 to align us with the Hampshire system
- Our primary feed is to Midhurst, however many children go on to Hampshire schools.

From Reception onwards children learn to use this modern technology to enhance well respected traditional teaching methods.

Our extra-curricular activities include: French, dance, gardening, football, netball, choir, construction club, string and brass instrument tuition.
